WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, under the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, education and general welfare of Tribal Members; **and**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the Tribe to purchase lands adjacent to Tribally owned property, for the purpose of adding to the Tribe's land base, and for possible future development; and

WHEREAS, an offer has been made and accepted to purchase the Whitener property (legal description attached) by Island Enterprises, and for the Tribe.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby approve the purchase of said property; **and**

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, the signatories on all escrow documents and/or documents pertaining to the purchase of said property, will be the Tribal Council Vice Chairman, Calvin Peters, and the Tribal Council Secretary, Susan McFarlane.



QUITCLAIM DEED

IN THE MATTER OF SR 101, SR 108 Interchange.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the STATE OF WASHINGTON, for and consideration of EXCHANGE FOR OTHER LANDS NECESSARY FOR TRANSPORTATION PURPOSES hereby conveys and quitclaims unto JOHN H. MOORE and PEARL MOORE, husband and wife, all right, title and interest under the jurisdiction of the Department of Transportation, in and to the following described real property situated in Mason County, State of Washington:

All that portion of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 18, Township 19 North, Range 3 West, W.M., deeded to the State of Washington by deed dated September 15, 1958 and recorded October 3, 1958 under File No. 175407 that lies easterly of a line described as beginning at a point opposite Highway Engineer's Station (hereinafter referred to as HES) S-EW 3+37.32 on the S-EW Line survey of SR 101, SR 108 Interchange and 106.55 feet southeasterly therefrom; thence northerly to a point opposite HES S-EW 3+73.57 and 84.77 feet southeasterly therefrom; thence northerly to a point opposite HES S-EW 4+50.79 and 54.28 feet southeasterly therefrom; thence northeasterly to a point opposite HES S-EW 5+02.61 and 56.55 feet southeasterly therefrom; and the end of this line description.

The grantees herein, their successors or assigns, shall have no right of ingress and egress to, from and between said SR 101 and the lands herein conveyed; nor shall the grantees herein, their successors or assigns, be entitled to compensation for any loss of light, view and air occasioned by the location, construction, maintenance or operation of said highway.

The specific details concerning all of which may be found on sheet 2 of that certain plan entitled SR 101, SR 108 Interchange, now of record and on file in the office of the Secretary of Transportation at Olympia, Washington, bearing date of approval September 26, 1983.

The grantee as part consideration herein does hereby agree to comply with all civil rights and anti-discrimination requirements of RCW Chapter 49.60, as to the lands herein described.

The lands herein described are not required for State highway purposes and are conveyed pursuant to the provisions of RCW Chapter 47.12.130.
