



SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBE

Resolution No. 98 - 33 Of the SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe by the authority of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and,

WHEREAS, under the Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, and general welfare of the Squaxin Island Tribal Reservation residents; and,

WHEREAS, the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration has announced the availability of grants for the expansion of substance abuse capacity; and,

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council recognizes the importance of the expansion of substance abuse treatment opportunities to the Squaxin Island and other tribal communities;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize and support the submission of a grant application to the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Service Administration for the expansion of treatment at the Northwest Indian Treatment Center; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the Executive Director or the Director of the Northwest Indian Treatment Center to be the Tribe's signatory and representative in all future matters requiring Tribal authorization on this particular project, and that these authorities shall be for the duration of this project.

CERTIFICATION

The Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby certify that the foregoing resolution was adopted at the regular meeting of the Squaxin Island Tribal Council, held on this 11th day of June, 1998, at which time a quorum was present and was passed by a vote of 4 for and 0 against with 0 abstentions.
