



# SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBE

## RESOLUTION NO. 98-58 OF THE SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; **and**

**WHEREAS**, under the Constitution and the By-laws of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, education and general welfare of Tribal Members; **and**

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribe has contracted for the codification of Tribal Ordinances; **and**

**WHEREAS**, after review certain resolutions have been identified that need to be repealed; **and**


**WHEREAS**, it is determined that Resolution No 84-51 was superseded by Resolution 90-44 that adopted the revised "Fishing Code"; **and**

**WHEREAS**, the "Fishing Code" cover the disposition of confiscated and abandoned property in Section 3.15; **and**


**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby repeal Resolution No. 84-51.
