RESOLUTION NO. 98- 66
of the
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe by the authority of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, under the Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, and general welfare of the Squaxin Island Tribal Reservation residents; and,

WHEREAS, under the Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has the powers and duties to acquire, manage or lease Tribal real property and other Tribal assets; and,

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs requires individual applications and resolutions to be submitted for each parcel of land that the Tribe wishes to convey from fee status to trust status; and,

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has requested that the United States Government accept Title for 2 parcels of land in Trust for the Squaxin Island Tribe by one Tribal Resolution No. 94-81.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby rescind Resolution No. 94-81, so that two separate resolutions requesting trust status may be adopted for the two parcels of land referenced in Resolution No. 94-81.

The Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby certify that the foregoing Resolution was adopted at a regular meeting of the Squaxin Island Tribal Council, held on this 9th day of July, 1998, at which time a quorum was present and was passed by a vote of 04 for, and 0 against, with 0 abstentions.
