



SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBE

RESOLUTION NO. 98-84
of the
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe by the authority of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and,

WHEREAS, under the Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security, and general welfare of the Squaxin Island Tribal Reservation residents; and,

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires applicants seeking Indian Community Development Block Grant funds (1) to assure public participation in their planning processes, (2) to seek review of plans by community members, and (3) to obtain feedback through methods which are familiar to the community; and,

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is committed to a planning process which is community driven, and has held public meetings during which infrastructure development, including drinking water, roads, power, and wastewater have been discussed and approved.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby assure HUD that substantial community input has been obtained during the last 24 months regarding infrastructure development, and that the Tribal Council will continue to obtain community review throughout the project implementation.

CERTIFICATION

The Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby certify that the foregoing Resolution was adopted at the regular meeting of the Squaxin Island Tribal Council, held on this 27th day of Aug, 1998, at which time a quorum was present and was passed by a vote of 4 for and 0 against with 0 abstentions.
