**Set Nets: Maximum Length 100 feet
Minimum Stretch 5 Inches**

Beach Seines - Maximum Length 600 feet/ Mesh Size: 3 Inch Min- 4 Inch Max

OTHER RESTRICTIONS: Set Nets have priority over Beach Seines in Skookum. There must be 100 ft between nets. All waters west of a line extending from the “No Hunting” sign near the mouth of Elson Creek to the point of land on the opposite shore are closed. All waters within 200 feet of radius of any stream entering Skookum Inlet are closed. The Totten/Skookum boundary is defined as a line extending from the Tillicum Rock (On the Arcadia side) to a large rock on Kamilche Point. Waters east of this line are Totten and are closed. There shall be navigable water maintained between nets. No nets shall be tied together.

JUSTIFICATION: COMMERCIAL HARVEST OF CHUM SALMON.

In Accordance with the Squaxin Island Fishing Ordinance, This Regulation is Hereby Approved.
