



SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBE

2024 FIREWORKS GENERAL USE PERMIT

The Squaxin Island Tribal Council approves the following General Use Permit as a substitute for the individual use permits required under the Squaxin Island Tribe's Fireworks and Safety Ordinance, SITC § 6.0.4.065 (the "Code").

A violation of this use permit may result in a misdemeanor charge under the Code.

The Squaxin Island Tribal Council strongly encourages families to discharge legal fireworks on the ballfield of the Reservation for the following times:

Wednesday, July 3, 2024 between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.
Thursday, July 4, 2024 between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 12:00 midnight
Friday, July 5, 2024 between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 12:00 midnight
Saturday, July 6, 2024 between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 12:00 midnight
Sunday, July 7, 2024 between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.

The discharge of fireworks before July 3 and after July 7 remains illegal.

The discharge of fireworks after 12:00 midnight is not permitted and is illegal.

The discharge of fireworks on any day where the temperature reaches above 95 degrees is illegal that particular day.

This permit allows for the discharge of fireworks within the residential lands only. Fireworks are not permitted on any other Squaxin Island properties.

Prohibited Fireworks: Only consumer fireworks may be discharged on or onto the Reservation. Consumer fireworks are those fireworks formerly classified as Class C Common Fireworks and now classified as Fireworks 1.4G under federal law. Consumer fireworks generally include cone fountains, cylindrical fountains, roman candles, skyrockets, firecrackers, mines and shells, helicopter type rockets, certain sparklers and revolving wheels. Consumer fireworks generally do not include M-80's, M-100's quarter sticks, blockbusters, cherry bombs and similar devices. See SITC § 6.04.130 (A)(2).
