Other Restrictions: Outer Budd Inlet is defined as all marine waters north of a line running east to west from Squaxin Point (N 47°04'14.65", W 122°54'05.96") through the #4 buoy (N 47°04'24.12", W 122°55'03.00") to the opposite shore and south of a line projected from Cooper Point (N 47°08'44.20", W 122°55'33.40") to the light at Dofflemeyer Point (N 47° 08'25.80", W 122°54'26.20") near Boston Harbor. Eld Inlets outer portion includes all waters north and east of a line projected due east from Flapjack Point (N 47°06'28.40", W 122°57'21.17") to the opposite shore (N 47°05'58.07", W 122°56'57.03"), to the northern 13G boundary. This portion of Eld Inlet is open to allow harvest of Budd Inlet Chinook milling at the mouth of Eld Inlet. Refer to the Annual Regulation 23-01 for Northern Case Inlet Closures: Sherwood Creek, Coulter Creek and Rocky Bay-Vaughn Bay Closures are in effect. All waters of Southern Case Inlet 13D south and east of a line extending from Johnson Point (N 47°10'40.92", W 122°48'53.69") to Devils Head Light (N 47°09'58.901", W 122°45'53.30") will be closed. Chinook Beach Seines Must Release All Coho. Be aware of excessive boat traffic during Labor Day Weekend August 30 - September 2, 2024.
