Other Totten Inlet Restrictions: All waters of Totten Inlet southwest of a line running northwest from the northern tip of Burns Point through the double pilings north of the Olympia Oyster Company building to the shore are Closed (Kennedy Creek closure). Skookum Inlet is only open from 6 AM-6 PM on Sunday & Monday.

**Eld Inlet**: In those waters north of a line extending northeast from JM Peters dock to the point on the opposite shore and south of a line extending from Flapjack Point to the northernmost point of land at the entrance to Green Cove: **Drift/Set Nets-** Max Length 300 feet/ Min Stretch: 5 inches

In those waters north of the aforementioned Flapjack Point Green Cove boundary to the northern 13G boundary: **Drift/Set Nets-** Max Length 600 feet/ Min Stretch: 5 inches

**Other Eld Inlet Restrictions:** Nets may not be set over private oyster beds. All waters south of a line extending from JM Peters dock to the point of land on the opposite shore are closed.
